- A. The Accessible Information Standard is a mandatory standard that all NHS and publicly funded adult social care services must follow to support people with a communication or information need.

5 important steps

The aim

People will have information they can understand and the communication support they need.



Ask if people have any information or communication needs and find out how to meet those needs.



2 Record

Record those needs in a set way that is highly visible, using specific definitions.



3 Flag

Use alerts or flags to make it clear on the person's record what their needs are, and prompt action to meet those needs.



4 Share

Share information about the person's needs with other NHS and adult social care providers.



5 Meet

Make sure people get their information in an accessible way and have the communication support they need.
